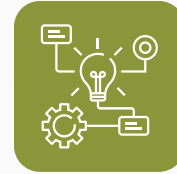

Incorrect word messages, symbols or color

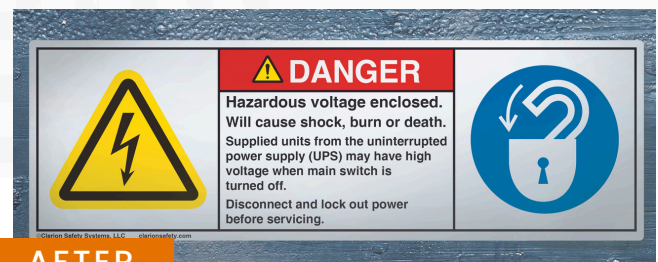
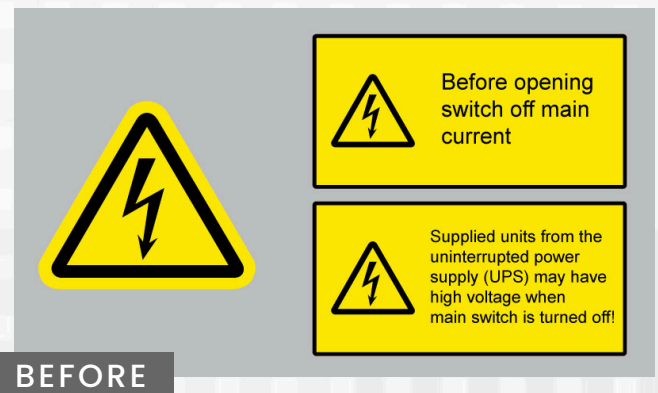
The problem: Failure to adequately warn users of hazard information on individual products and across product lines means greater risk to worker safety - and potential lawsuits should an accident occur.
